Constructed in 1932, the Pulaski Skyway at 3.5 Miles long was one of the first Super Highways in the United States. Almost hundred years later, this historic steel truss structure is now in the midst of a multi-stage rehabilitation effort to continue its serviceability to the traveling public. These efforts include everything from replacement of the deck to rehabilitation of the truss members and piers. Presented by Joseph Strafacci, PE of HNTB and Jay Jeyamohan of NJDOT, the presentation will provide a detailed review of HNTB's ongoing design efforts to the skyway which includes the rehabilitation to the Rocker Bents, Piers and Structural Steel Members.
